

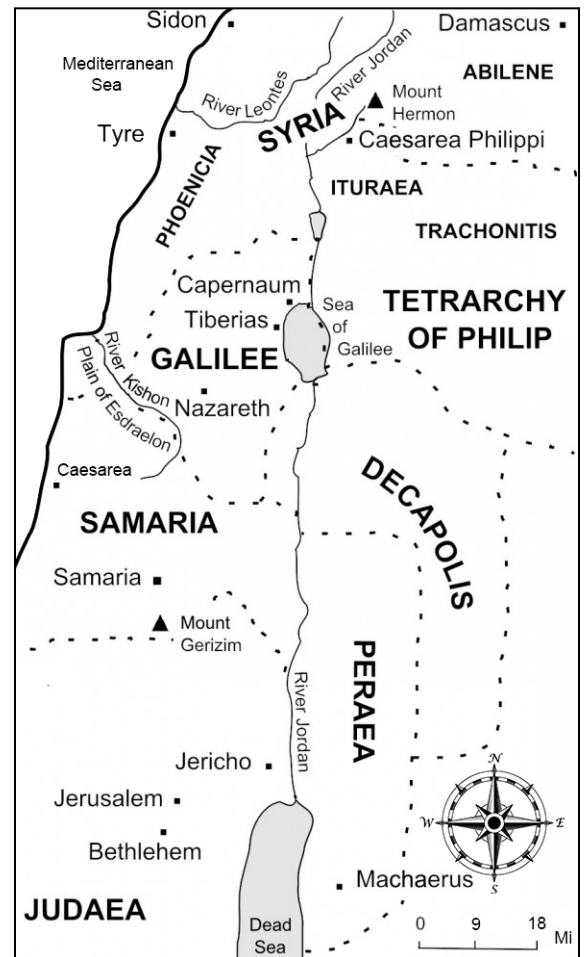
# The Chosen, Season 1: Episode 3

## Context

- Capernaum, 26 A.D.
  - 26 A.D. is just before Jesus starts his ministry
  - Capernaum was a fishing village on the north of the Sea of Galilee
- “The Spirit of the Lord is on me, because he has anointed me to proclaim good news to the poor. He has sent me to proclaim freedom for the prisoners and recovery of sight for the blind, to set the oppressed free, to proclaim the year of the Lord’s favor.” (see Luke 4:18-19 / Isaiah 61:1-2)

## Discussion

- What did you think of Jesus’ interaction with the children and his gift to Abigail? Is that how you picture Jesus?
